

# SKÅNELAHOLMS CASTLE & FOLK MUSEUM

## Open for visitors

The Castle is open 11 AM to 4 PM from 2 of May to 30 of Sept in connection to guided tours. (Closed: Midsummer Eve 22 of May and Midsummer Day 23 of May)  
The kids workshop has the same opening hours. Kids in all ages can learn how to spinning, comb wool, weave, braid and Rag Rug. make your own candle, try calligraphy or mold clay. Material costs: 80 SEK.

## This summer's exhibition

*"Lin blir gull"* The exhibition is open during the castles opening hours.

The park is open all year round to visitors (The winter maintenance on the smaller paths around the castle can be limited during harsh conditions)

## Guided tours of the castle

Wednesday to Sunday tours starts at 11 AM, 12PM, 2 PM (family tour) and 3PM.  
The tour takes about one hour and is included in the entrance ticket.  
Entrance ticket: Adults 60 SEK. Free entrance for kids and youths under 19 years old.

## Guided tours of the Folk Museum

30 June, 1 July, 28 July, 29 July, 12 August, 25 August, 26 August, 16 September;  
11 AM, 12 PM, 2 PM and 3 PM.  
Entrance ticket: Adults 40 SEK. Free entrance for kids and youths under 19 years old.

## Themed tours: *The Women of Skånelaholm.*

30 June, 4 July, 5 July, 6 July, 8 July; kl.13.  
Entrance ticket: Adults 60 SEK. Free entrance for kids and youths under 19 years old.

**Group tours:** By appointment only, also possible other hours than the regular opening hours. We offer tours in English, Estonian, Finnish, Japanese, Russian and German.

Group ticket: 500 SEK + 50 SEK for every participant. Groups up to 25 persons.
